

Welcome to 2023 HYSA United Northwoods Competitive Soccer!

Early registration is key for the spring season to be a success. HYSA United is offering a \$50 discount for each player that signs up before December 1, 2022. And sooner is better.

The club's ability to involve coaches, create rosters, schedule practices, order uniforms, and register for games & tournaments depends on you getting your players signed up. Help us ensure your player has a positive experience and success in our spring competitive program by signing up now.

AGAIN THIS SEASON:

UNIFORMS - For the competitive league this season, each player will receive a full uniform (jersey(s) & shorts) that they will keep. The cost is included with the registration fee.

CANCELLATION POLICY - Due to the need to register teams for jamborees and tournament play in a timely manner, HYSA United will enforce the following cancellation policy should your player withdraw after registration is completed:

- Cancellations through December 31, 2022 will receive a 100% refund.
- Cancellations January 1, 2023 through January 15, 2023 will receive a 50% refund.
- Cancellations after February 1, 2023 will not receive a refund.

Regardless of date - if HYSA United is unable to roster your player on an age appropriate team due to low registration numbers you will receive a 100% refund via the payment method you registered with.

OTHER NOTES:

- **You will see player levels as follows: 9U/10U** (2014/2013 DOB), **11U** (2012 DOB), **12U** (2011 DOB), **13U** (2010 DOB), **14U** (2009 DOB), **15U** (2008 DOB), **and 16U/17U - HS** (2007/2006 DOB).
- It is our goal to grow the program in 2023 and have as many teams with a single birth year as possible. This allows the best chance to be competitive. Accomplishing this depends solely on the number of players that sign up - spread the word and encourage others to be a part!
- Even more ideal is to have girls only or boys only teams which helps us compete against other clubs that have this ability.
- As registrations come in, age groupings may be adjusted and changed to co-ed teams depending on actual numbers. A 2-year age grouped team (ex 11 & 12 year olds playing at 12U) is the alternative approach that will be taken if a single year age team cannot be rostered.
- It's impossible to predict until the actual numbers come in. So, again - sign up early and help the program by encouraging others to be involved.
- **Upload your player's photo.** This is for the purpose of player cards only, which is required for tournaments in which your player may participate. These should be basic "headshots" of the player's face or upper torso only.
- **Jamborees are UNKNOWN this season.** 2022 was tough due to canceled events and schedule changes. We'll update you as soon as we know more about what these are looking for this season. In years past these were held in Hayward, Ashland, Rice Lake, etc.
- **For 2023 it is planned to attend 3 tournaments.** We are looking at Oshkosh, Wausau, Stevens Point, Appleton and others as options. At this time the 2023 tournament details are not yet posted by the event

coordinators. However it's likely that tournament play will begin in early May and go through early to mid June.

- Tournaments are Saturday/Sunday events. Typically traveling Friday night to the event is advised and games end mid afternoon on Sunday for those that advance.
- This is a **commitment** for sure. However, if your weekend schedule is limited for whatever reason there is usually someone on the team that is willing to welcome your player to ride share.

Financial Aid

If you are unable to pay the player fees at the time of registration, please select "financial aid" in the payment section.

- Contact us via email - hysaunited@gmail.com so we can arrange a time to discuss options and a plan that works for you. This will be a one on one conversation between you and the registrar or another club administrator.
- All exchanges will be kept in strict confidence and held private with the executive board (president, vice, treasurer, secretary, registrar).
- Financial assistance is based on an "honor" system. No personal financial information will need to be disclosed.
- If you have a need - ask and we'll find a way to work with you.
- No player is turned away due to the ability to pay.

Among the options that will be explored are:

- Extended or longer term payments (no interest).
- Additional volunteer/contributor hours to give back in kind hours to the program.
- Taking on a board position or other special projects or roles (ex. field maintenance lead, uniform inventory, equipment inventory, fundraiser lead, etc) to give back in kind hours to the program.

A few notes about the season:

ATTIRE: Plan on bringing water bottles, shin guards, cleats and comfortable clothes to practice. Uniforms for game day (jersey and shorts) will be included with your registration fees.

PRACTICE: When the fields are ready, practices will be held at Oldenburg Sports Park 2 days per week, typically Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs, depending on the volunteer coaches' schedules. You will be notified directly from your player's coach.

FEES: Your player registration fees cover registration and insurance costs with WYSA, application fees for league games and tournaments, uniform (jersey(s) and shorts for game day), game equipment and field maintenance and upkeep. Player families are responsible for cleats, socks (2 pairs/colors - TBD), shin guards and travel expenses for games and tournaments.
